We trust in your goodness.

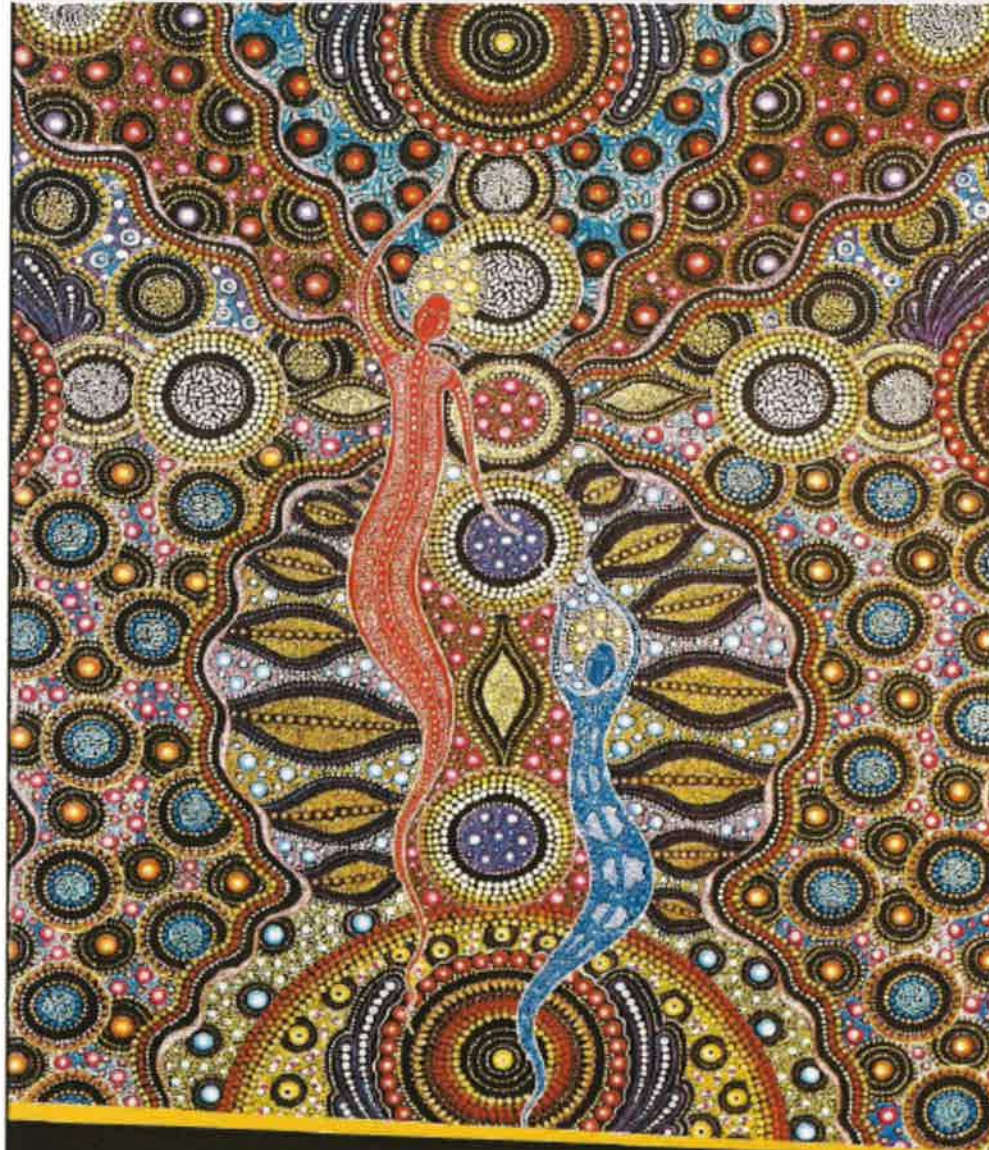
**You are Lord, our Saviour,
