Mighty healer and friend.**

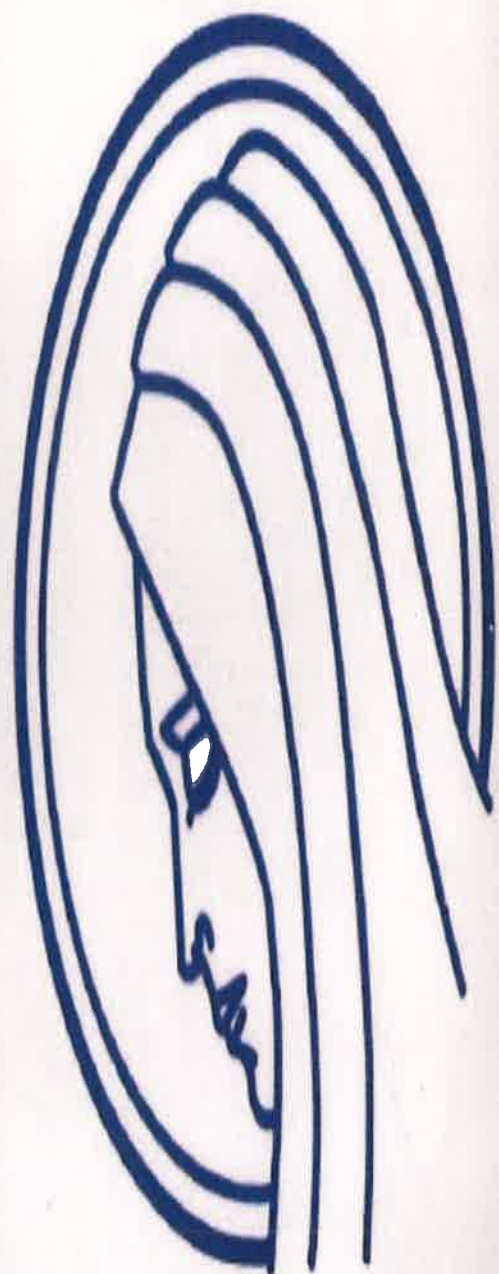
