The Bishop's confirmation and visitation programme are suspended, and this will be reassessed later in the year. In individual Parishes, Confirmation lessons may still be conducted in the Catholic schools. However, Parish based preparation programmes should not continue until further notice.

1ST HOLY COMMUNION

All 1st Holy Communion Masses will obviously be suspended and reassessed later in the year. It is a local decision as to whether preparation is still incorporated into the school programme. Parish based preparation programmes should not continue until further notice.

SPECIAL RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The SRE programme in the Diocese has been suspended. Many individual schools and other denominations have already suspended their SRE lessons. It is likely that all volunteers will be unable to enter State schools in the very near future. A key concern in the Diocese was the age of many of the catechists placing many in the high-risk category.

We are back in the early days of European Settlement in Australia when Catholics had no churches, no priests and therefore no sacramental life and, especially hard, no Sunday Mass. They held to their Faith through prayer, study of the Catechism, reading the scripture and of course the Family Rosary. And they cared for each other as neighbours. It was far from being an easy time for our forebears in the faith, quite the opposite....
