### PLENARY INDULGENCE

A plenary indulgence which is applicable only to the souls in Purgatory is granted to the faithful who **devoutly visit a church or an oratory on All Souls Day and pray the Lord's Prayer and the Creed.**

Likewise, a plenary indulgence which is applicable only to the souls in Purgatory is granted to the faithful who **devoutly visit a cemetery from November 1st-8th and pray for the dead.** This is granted for each of these days **and so may be obtained each separate day.**

Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

- ◆ Do the prescribed good work
- ◆ Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of the work (several plenary indulgences may be earned per reception)
- ◆ Receive Eucharistic communion preferably on the day but within several days of the indulgenced act (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception)
- ◆ Pray for the pope's intentions
- ◆ Exclusion of attachment to sin (even venial)
